

# Taxi and Limousine Commission

The Westchester County Taxi and Limousine Commission governs the licensing and regulation of the county's taxi and limousine industry. The commission was established first and foremost to ensure safe and quality livery for the riding public and to promote the improvement of for-hire vehicle services.

To this end, the WCTLC has a county-wide inter-municipal policy that sets forth rules and regulations for the for-hire industry in Westchester and sets standards for drivers, vehicles and base stations.

Our applications for drivers, vehicles and base stations can be viewed online and downloaded. Some are available in Spanish. The WCTLC service window is open to the general public Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

The Westchester County Taxi and Limousine Commission (WCTLC) regulates and licenses the base stations, vehicles and drivers that do business in Westchester County.

## Base Stations

Base stations are the point from which all operations are conducted. They receive calls from the public to schedule and dispatch for-hire vehicles. Base stations are where company records, required by the WCTLC, are kept for inspection.

The base station inspection by WCTLC personnel are conducted at least once a year.

**Vehicles** All for-hire vehicles must be licensed by WCTLC and display "W - C" plates in order to do point-to-point trips within Westchester County.

NYC and Nassau County TLC plates are recognized by WCTLC for single point trips within this county.

New applicants are fingerprinted by the TLC. Criminal background checks are also conducted on every new applicant. All TLC drivers undergo drug testing on an annual basis.

Drivers are monitored throughout the year to ensure their driving records remain within the standards set by the TLC.
