| DRIVER SAFETY REQUIREMENTS | DRUG TESTING PROGRAM |

| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Fingerprints/background check ■ DMV driving history ■ Annual drug test ■ Class A, B, C or E NYS driver license ■ or equivalent from CT/NJ ■ Completion of a state-approved defensive driving course. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ All driver applicants are drug tested. ■ All driver permit holders are drug tested annually, upon renewal, and additional drug testing no less than often than once per year as directed. ■ Failure to pass or take the drug test results in the denial of the WCTLC driver permit application. |
| DMV DRIVING HISTORY | |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Electronic database connection with NYS DMV enables WCTLC to review Applicant's driving history. ■ WCTLC reviews each applicant to determine, on an individual basis, the applicant's fitness to obtain a WCTLC driver permit. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ WCTLC continues to monitor a permit holder's driving activities through NYS DMV's License Event Notification Service (LENS). ■ Automatic disqualification of applicant if convicted of DWI (5 years) or DWAI (3 years). |
| CRITICAL DRIVER PROGRAM | PERSISTENT VIOLATOR PROGRAM |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Points assessed by the state DMV for violations of State Vehicle and Traffic Law are monitored via the LENS program. ■ Accumulation of six (6) points within 15 month period warrants a 30 day suspension of WCTLC driver permit ■ Accumulation of ten (10) points within 15 month period warrants a six month revocation of WCTLC driver permit ■ Two points are reduced from the Critical Driver Program point total for the completion of a Defensive Driving Course ■ Suspensions/revocations may be appealed through hearing with an ALJ | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Point accumulations are monitored for violations of WCTLC Rules & Regulations. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Points are assessed on WCTLC driver permit at WCTLC adjudication hearing. ● A driver will not receive points under both the Critical Driver Program and the Persistent Violator Program for the same offense. ■ Accumulation of six (6) points within 15 month period warrant a 30 day suspension of WCTLC driver permit ■ Accumulation of ten (10) points within 15 month period warrants a six month revocation of WCTLC driver permit ■ Suspensions/revocations may be appealed through hearing with an ALJ |
